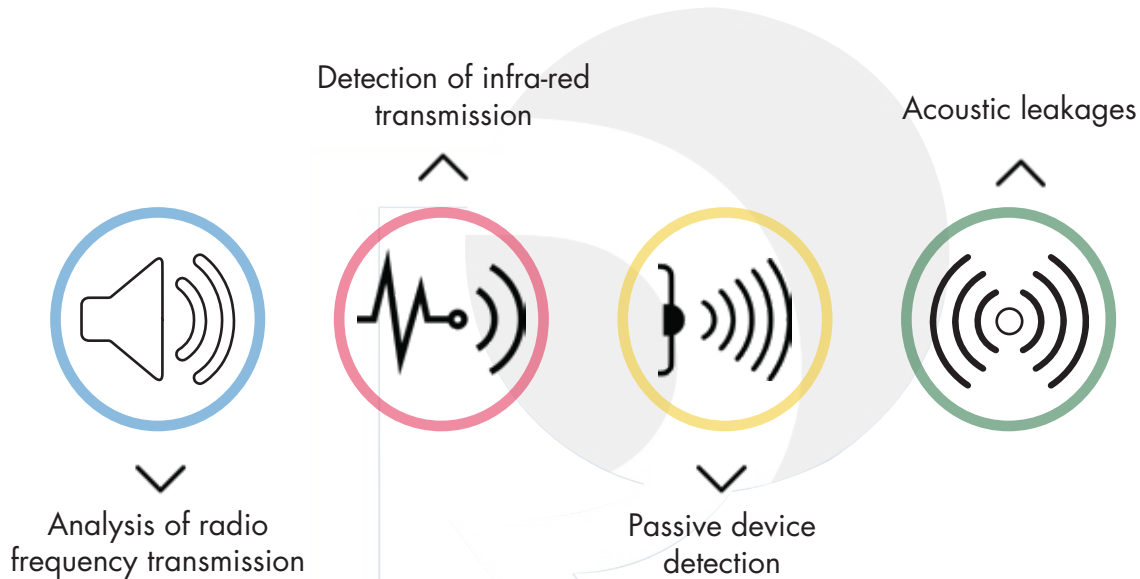


TECHNICAL SURVEILLANCE COUNTERMEASURES (TSCM)

What is TECHNICAL SURVEILLANCE COUNTERMEASURES (TSCM)?

Technical Surveillance Counter Measures services was coined by the US Government to denote the systematic process of sweeping a specific location for any electronic listening devices, bugs, covert cameras or other similar eavesdropping devices.



Why do we need TECHNICAL SURVEILLANCE COUNTERMEASURES (TSCM)?

As commercial competition becomes more global and corporate data - anything from designs, processes, client data, price structures through to executive decisions - more valuable and crucial than ever before, the threat from third parties seeking to illicitly obtain this corporate data expands each day.

The benefits of stealing corporate data are obvious - avoiding expensive R&D, gaining a competitive edge, breaking into new markets, targetting specific clients - whilst the downsides don't have much of a deterrent effect - unlikely to be detected, caught or prosecuted due to the sensitivity /embarrassment factors.

Though cyberattacks have recently gained attention due to the theft of data at Yahoo!, Sony etc., the threat for medium to large scale companies from listening devices [often known as 'bugs'] is considerable. Simple to complex listening devices can now be bought on the internet for a few hundred dollars and can be placed inside company buildings to listen to sensitive meetings, discussions and conversations.

When to use TSCM?
